Sitarambhai Naranji Patel Institute of Technology, Umrakh-Bardoli has successfully organized, hosted and completed 6th south zone Youth Festival XITIJ-2016 with the theme of "Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan" in association with Gujarat Technological University, from 29th September to 1st October 2016. Total 52 institutes of South Gujarat zone were invited for participation and to showcase their talent. The event was planned at the institute with the initiatives of Dr.Neeraj D. Sharma, Dr. Piyush Jain and his team. The invitation was sent to various institutes from the official email-ld XITIJ16_zone5@snpitrc.ac.in along with the various annexure, guidelines and details given by GTU.

Introduction of Youth Festival (XITIJ-2016-17):

"XITIJ" name given to the youth festival organized by Gujarat Technological University (GTU). "XITIJ 2016" is the 6th youth festival by GTU for its degree Engineering, M.E, MBA, Pharmacy students. The Youth festival is divided in five different zones of Gujarat.

- 1. Ahmadabad Zone
- 2. Gandhinagar Zone
- 3. Vallabh-Vidyanagar Zone
- 4. Rajkot Zone
- 5. Surat Zone

After completion of youth festival at five different zones, the inter-zonal will be organized at the nominated institute where all the winners from the different zones will show-case their best talent to strive for winning inter-zonal competition.

S. N. Patel Institute hosted the south zone youth festival for the second time from 29th September to 1st October 2016. During the festival, 24 various events under 5 major categories of Music, Dance, Theatre, Literature and Fine Arts were organized. Total 20 Institute's team has been registered with total 607 participants. The registration was completed as per the norms before one week prior to the commencement of youth festival.

REGISTRATIONS & BREAKFAST:

On 29th September, as per the planned schedule the registration for the event and document verification started by 8 A.M and continued even on the second and third day. Prof. Bhavin Kashiyani, faculty of civil engineering dept. and his team planned and managed the registration process precisely in the prescribed manner. They put up a fantastic show and provided the smooth registrations to all the participative colleges. Registration of 20 colleges took place into various 5 main counters along with an extra counter provided to help the participants and team managers related to any quarry. All the colleges were provided separate rest rooms where all the participants, accompanists & team leaders placed their props. All the registered Institutes team managers have been provided the kit containing food coupons, ID cards and copies of event schedules. This marked the end of the ceremony as well as the end of this huge mass of youth fest XITIJ: 2016-17. At the end after Anthem ceremony concluded.





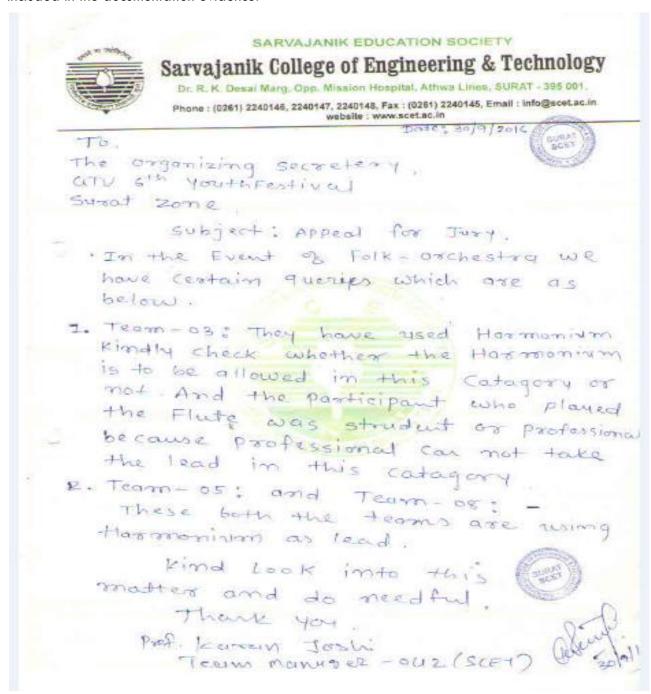
